#### SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard Bridge Fender Replacement Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House for the bridge fender replacement project on the SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard Bridge, over the Intracoastal Waterway in the City of Riviera Beach.

Construction Cost: \$1,592,830

Construction Start: July 12, 2019

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2020

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Remove and replace bridge fender system
- Replace the navigational lighting system
- Remove all platforms and ladders from the bridge

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures may occur nightly, 10 p.m. until 3 a.m.
- Access to the channel under the bridge will remain open; channel restrictions will be needed to stage equipment
