## US 1/SR 5 Resurfacing Project in Delray Beach

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, will host a Virtual Public Meeting for the roadway resurfacing project on US 1/SR 5 from south of Eve Street to south of Harbourside Drive in the City of Delray Beach.

Construction Cost: \$1,238,848 Construction Start: June 29, 2020 Anticipated Completion: Spring 2021

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing travel lanes and shoulders
- Drainage, signalization and signage improvements
- Pavement marking upgrades, including roadway striping for bike lanes
- Sidewalk removal and replacement

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures are permitted, daily, 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., and nightly, 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday night through Friday afternoon
- One lane will remain open in each direction during all work activities
- Sidewalks will be closed as needed for reconstruction, with pedestrian detours in place
