### SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the improvements project on SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard, from Lyons Road to Florida's Turnpike, in unincorporated Palm Beach County.

Construction Cost: \$2,092,533

Construction Start: July 12, 2020

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2021

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway
- Minor widening for increased length of the eastbound and westbound turn lanes at the northbound entrance to Florida's Turnpike
- Pedestrian pole, guardrail, signage and pavement marking upgrades, including green striping for bike lanes
- Installation of sidewalk and ADA detectable warning mats
- Minor drainage and lighting upgrades

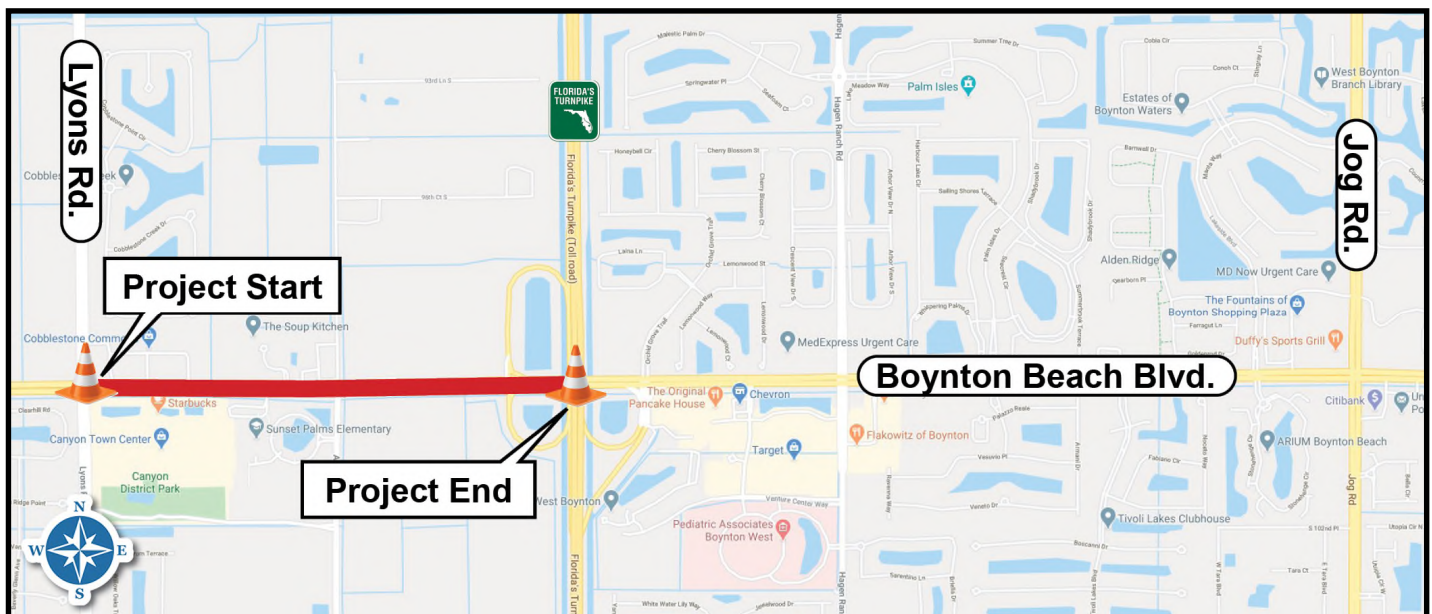

- One lane may be closed in each direction, daily, 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday
- Two lanes may be closed in each direction, nightly, 8:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night
