Please visit <u>www.d4fdot.com</u> for information on FDOT construction projects in Palm Beach County. n Tuesday, July 18, 2017, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the improvements project on Lyons Road, just south of Glades Road from Norte Lago to Pine Springs Drive, at the Glades Road Branch of the Palm Beach County Library, 20701 96th Avenue S, Boca Raton, Florida, 33434.

Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, construction schedule, and address questions and comments one-onone. <u>Please note</u>: There will not be a formal presentation. Guests may arrive at any time between 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.

This 0.693-mile project will begin Monday, July 10, and is expected to be completed in late summer 2018, weather permitting. The construction cost is \$3.5 million. Work is being performed by Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., with FDOT overseeing the project.

Scope of Work:

- Reconstruction of three (3) existing horizontal curves
- Roadway milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements
- Sidewalk, signing and pavement marking installation
- Curb ramp upgrades to meet ADA compliance
- New southbound right turn lane from Lyons Rd. to Norte Lago

Maintenance of Traffic:

In order to do this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at various times and locations. Work will be done in four (4) phases to minimize impacts on the community and motoring public. A temporary traffic signal will be installed at Lyons Road and Escondido Way during Phase 1B, with coordination through the Palm Beach County Engineering Department. However, a permanent signal will not be installed under this contract. The temporary signal will be removed prior to the completion of this FDOT construction project.

Only one lane of traffic will be open in each direction for Phase 1, from approximately July 2017 through December 2017. Intermittent lane closures may occur from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. during this time, with flagmen on-site to direct traffic. For Phases 2 - 4, project-related lane closures can be expected daily, 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. When the contractor is not working on-site, two lanes of traffic will be open in each direction.
