SR A1A/HAVEN ASHE BRIDGE MAINTENANCE PROJECT OVER THE BOCA RATON INLET

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Virtual Public Meeting regarding the routine maintenance and repair of the SR A1A/Haven Ashe Bridge over the Boca Raton Inlet in the city of Boca Raton. There will be brief presentations followed by comments and questions from the public at 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Paint the steel and concrete portions of the SR A1A/Haven Ashe Bridge (Bridge No. 930060)

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- A full bridge closure will occur during bridge painting operations for a maximum of 60 days. Traffic will be detoured to Federal Highway via East Palmetto Park Road and Hillsboro Boulevard.
- Bridge closures will not occur during some special events.
- Marine traffic will be maintained through the navigable waterway. Channel restrictions may occur.
