Beginning Sunday night, Aug. 13, the Ocean Avenue Bridge will undergo a full nighttime closure for bridge painting operations for three (3) consecutive nights. In order to complete painting operations, the bridge must be open and locked in the upright position for a total of six (6) nights.

The bridge will close at 9 p.m. and open at 5 a.m., **Sunday night, Aug. 13, Monday night, Aug. 14, and Tuesday night, Aug. 15.** Motorists may detour via US 1 or State Road A1A to Woolbright Road during the bridge closures.

The following week, the bridge will close again from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., **Sunday night, Aug. 20, Monday night, Aug. 21, and Tuesday night, Aug. 22.** *Please note, in the case of inclement weather, the painting operations will be performed the following night(s), as needed, until painting is completed.
