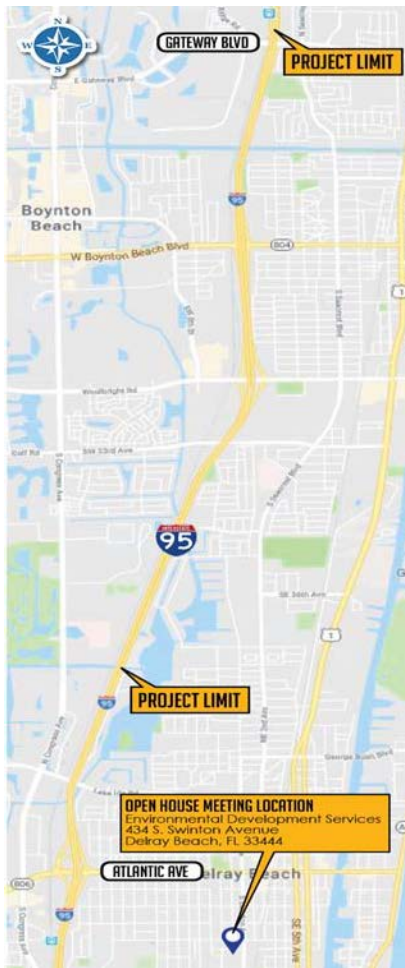
#### I-95 NORTH OF GATEWAY BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF ATLANTIC AVENUE

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House for the I-95 improvements project between Gateway Boulevard and Atlantic Avenue in the Cities of Boynton Beach and Delray Beach.

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Project improvements include milling, resurfacing, drainage improvements, guardrail, rumble strips, signing and pavement markings, and traffic monitoring site installation along I-95. Other improvements at select ramps along the corridor include: curb and gutter, sidewalks, and detectable warnings.

Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, construction schedule, and address questions and comments one-on-one. The open house will have an informal format. No formal presentation will be made. Guests may arrive at any time between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.
