Construction Cost: \$1.8M

Construction Start: Sept. 14, 2019

Anticipated Completion: Fall 2020

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Work may include sidewalk replacement, pavement widening and restoration, driveway reconstruction, drainage structure and pipe replacement, signage and pavement marking upgrades, and detectable warning systems at the following locations in the City of Belle Glade:

- 1) SW Ave. G: SW 14th St. to SW 12th St.
- 2) SE Ave. F: SE 1st St. to SE 2nd St.
- 3) SE Ave. F: SE 2nd St. to SE 7th Dr.
- 4) NE 1st St.: E. Canal St. N to NE Ave. F
- 5) NE 1st St.: NE Ave. H to NE Ave. L
- 6) NE Ave. H: SR 80/Main Street to NE 1st St.
- 7) NW 1st St.: NW Ave. L to NW Ave. H
- 8) NW 2nd St.: NW Ave. H to NW Ave. F
- 9) NW 2nd St.: NW Ave. F to NW Ave. E
- 10) NW 2nd St.: NW Ave. E to SR 717/W. Lake Rd.
- 11) SW 6th St.: Dr. MLK Blvd. to Ave. A
- 12) SW 5th St.: Dr. MLK Blvd. to W. Ave. A
- 13) W Ave. A: SW 6th St. to SW 4th St.

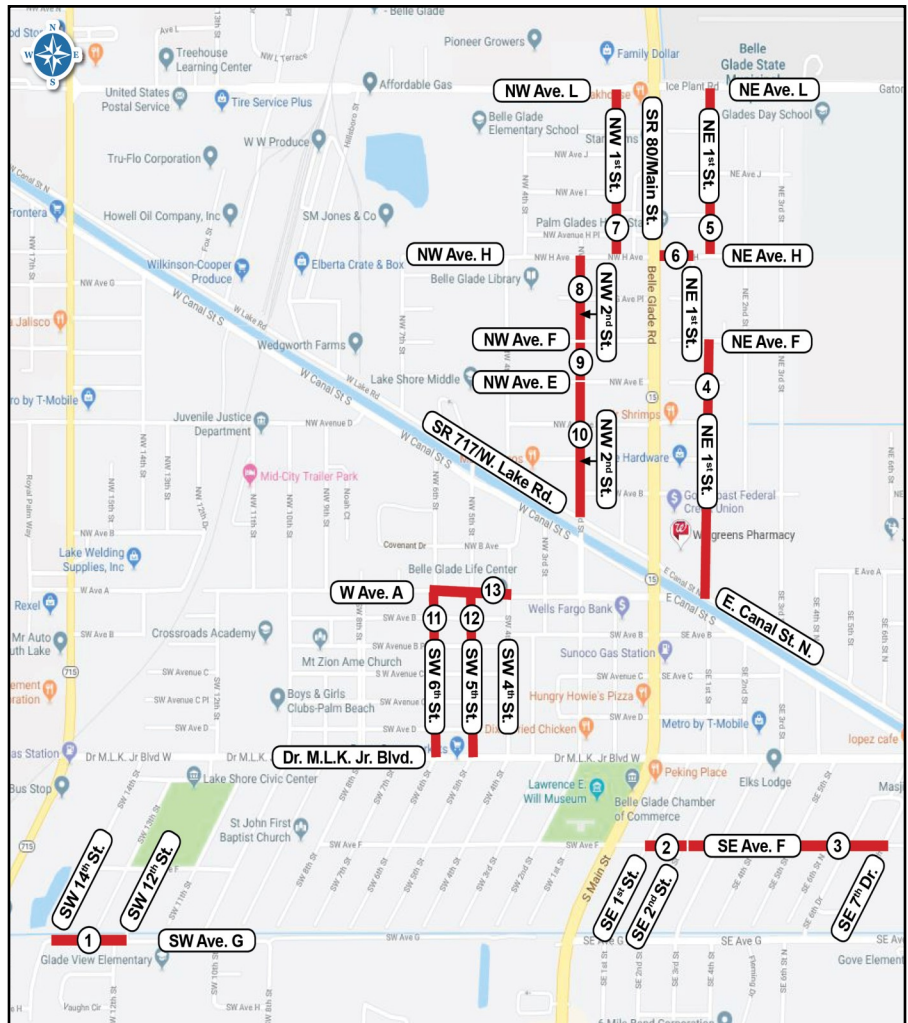
