

This activity is typically performed during the day, however the nighttime operation is necessary due to the close proximity to FPL power lines. In order to safely install these piles for the new bridge foundation, FPL has to de-energize the nearby power lines. To provide minimal impact to customers, FPL must wait until load has decreased significantly enough to de-energize.

This bridge construction operation is part of the \$69 million, 2.5-mile interchange project which began construction on January 13, 2014 and is expected to be completed in late summer 2017, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Astaldi Construction Corp., with Creative Engineering Group, Inc. administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.
