SR 80/SOUTHERN BOULEVARD AT FOREST HILL BOULEVARD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, will conduct a Construction Open House regarding intersection improvements for SR 80/Southern Boulevard at Forest Hill Boulevard in the cities of Royal Palm Beach and Wellington. The meeting will have an informal open house format beginning at 5:30 p.m. Representatives will be available to provide pertinent information and answer questions. Construction plans will be available for public viewing.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Adding a third westbound to southbound left-turn lane from SR 80 to Forest Hill Boulevard
- Converting the Forest Hill Boulevard right-turn lanes to a free-flowing right-turn lane
- Widening Southern Boulevard to accommodate an eastbound acceleration lane
- Widening the bridge over the C-51 Canal
- Milling and resurfacing the roadway
- Upgrading drainage, signalization, lighting, signage and pavement markings
- Installing curb and gutter, sidewalks and landscaping

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures may occur between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Lane closures are not permitted during some special events.
- Sidewalks will be closed periodically and pedestrian traffic detoured.

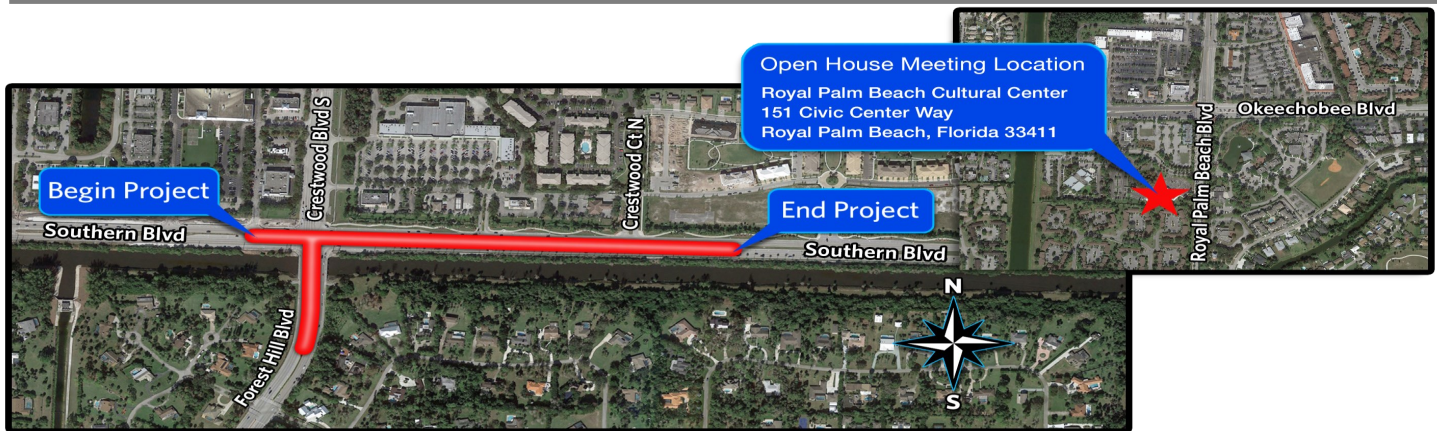
