Congress Avenue Lighting Improvements Project

Pedestrian detours will be installed as part of the lighting improvements project on Congress Avenue, from south of SR 710 to Blue Heron Boulevard, in the City of Riviera Beach. Pedestrian access will be maintained on one (1) side of Congress Avenue at all times. The detours below are expected to be in place through December 2019, then will shift for the next phase of the project.

Construction Cost: \$3,421,871

Construction to Begin: Oct. 4, 2019

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2020

SOUTHBOUND SIDEWALK CLOSURE & DETOUR

1) Congress Avenue from W. 13th Street to SR 710 will have the southbound sidewalk closed (west side of roadway) through December 2019

- **DETOUR:** Pedestrians may cross at the W. 13th Street/Congress Avenue intersection to access the sidewalk on the east side of Congress Avenue to travel south

NORTHBOUND SIDEWALK CLOSURES & DETOURS

2) Congress Avenue from W. 13th Street to Blue Heron Boulevard will have the northbound sidewalk closed (east side of roadway) through December 2019

- **DETOUR:** Pedestrians may cross at the W. 13th Street/Congress Avenue intersection to access the sidewalk on the west side of Congress Avenue to travel north

3) Congress Avenue from JFK North to SR 710 will have the northbound sidewalk closed (east side of roadway) through December 2019

- **DETOUR:** Pedestrians may cross at the JFK North/Congress Avenue intersection to access the sidewalk on the west side of Congress Avenue to travel north
