The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the I-95 at 10th Avenue North Bridge Beam Replacement Project in Palm Beach County.

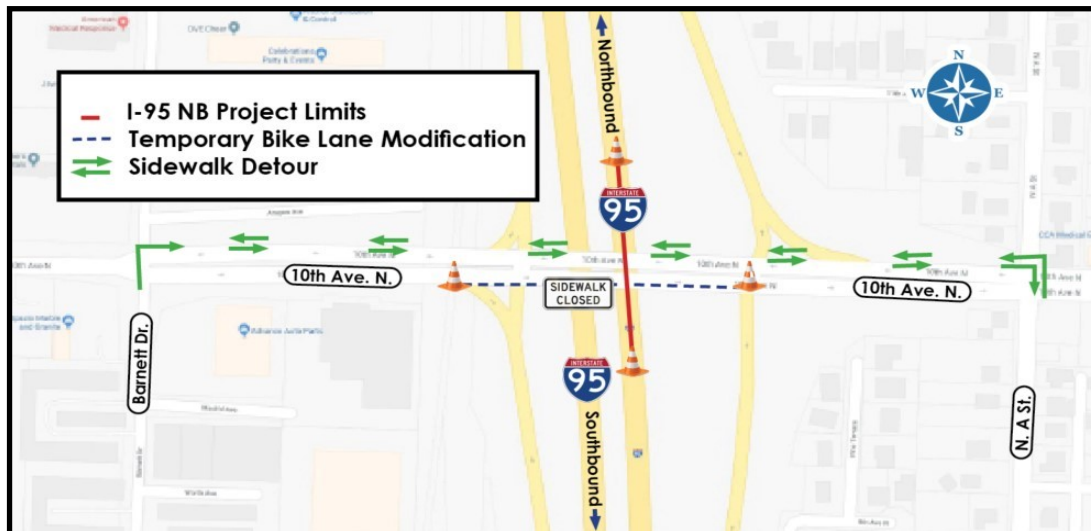

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PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Work includes removing and replacing the existing damaged bridge beam and replacing the bridge deck and barrier wall on the 10th Avenue North bridge over I-95 northbound.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures on I-95 are permitted nightly, 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. One lane of I-95 may close at 9:00 p.m., two lanes may close at 10:00 p.m. and three lanes may close at 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. All lanes will reopen by 6:00 a.m.
- One eastbound lane along 10th Avenue North at I-95 is permitted to be closed nightly, 11:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.
- To ensure pedestrian safety, the sidewalk and shoulder lane along eastbound 10th Avenue North will undergo a full closure for the duration of the project. Pedestrians will be detoured to the north sidewalk and bicyclists will temporarily share the general traffic lane for a 150 foot-long section.
- Seven (7) non-consecutive nights of full closures of I-95 northbound at 10th Avenue North will be needed to perform beam removal and replacement operations; three weeks of advanced notice will be provided to the public.
