BRIDGE TO REOPEN OCTOBER 8

The SR A1A/Haven Ashe Bridge over the Boca Raton Inlet will reopen to vehicle and pedestrian traffic at approximately noon on Thursday, October 8. Normal bridge operations have resumed with on-demand openings for marine vessels. Painting operations are anticipated to continue through the month of October.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

 This project in the city of Boca Raton consists of painting the steel and concrete portions of the State Road A1A/Haven Ashe Bridge over the Boca Raton Inlet (Bridge No. 930060).

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Intermittent sidewalk closures may occur. Northbound and southbound sidewalks will not be closed simultaneously.
- Marine traffic will be maintained through the navigable waterway.
