ollowing our weekly progress meeting, we offer this update for the I-95/Spanish River Boulevard Interchange construction project. Thursday, November 2, 2017 marks day 1558 of 1632; this project is now 95.4% completed.

#### **Bridge & Ramp Construction**

- MSE wall construction has been completed.
- Sound wall construction has been completed.
- All bridge construction is substantially complete.
- The new I-95 northbound exit ramp to Spanish River Boulevard (Exit 48A) is open.
- The new I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Spanish River Boulevard is open.

#### Roadway Construction

- Excavation of ponds is substantially complete.
- Widening, paving, and drainage operations on Yamato Rd., Spanish River Blvd., FAU Blvd., and I-95 between Spanish River Boulevard and Congress Ave. are ongoing.
- Traffic is shifted on FAU Boulevard to allow for roadway widening and new ramp entrance.
- Utility relocations have been completed.

#### El Rio Trail & T-Rex Trail

The trails are open to pedestrian traffic, dawn to dusk.

In November 2017, the contractor anticipates to:

- Continue roadway construction on FAU Blvd., Spanish River Blvd. and Yamato Rd.
- Continue new interchange ramp construction and reconstruction.
- Continue widening of I-95.
- Continue lighting installation along I-95 and the ramps.
- Continue construction of the El Rio Trail/Yamato Road & SFRTA underpasses.
- Continue ITS fiber installation along I-95 northbound.

#### Maintenance of Traffic

I-95 lane closures between Congress Avenue and Glades Road and interchange ramp closures at Congress Ave., and Yamato Rd. are ongoing, as needed, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The project team is coordinating with FAU stadium staff to minimize traffic impacts during football games & special events.
