Gateway Boulevard Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, will host a Construction Open House for improvements along Gateway Boulevard from east of High Ridge Road to east of I-95 in the City of Boynton Beach. The scope of work includes lane assignment modification for the outside eastbound through lane, new signalization and signage, median modifications and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades.

Construction Cost: \$552,417 Construction Start: January 6, 2020 Anticipated Completion: Late 2020

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Conversion of the eastbound outside through lane to a dual through and right-turn lane for the I-95 southbound entrance ramp.
- Median modifications
- ADA upgrades
- New signage and signalization

- Daily lane closures may occur Monday through Friday,
 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.
- Nightly lane closures may occur Sunday through Thursday nights, 7 p.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
