The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Congress Avenue will undergo a full closure, as needed, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday night, Dec. 10 through Thursday night, Dec. 14, for construction activities. Traffic will be detoured via I-95, Linton Boulevard and Congress Avenue.

This \$69 million, 2.5-mile project began construction on January 13, 2014 and is expected to be completed in winter 2017, weather permitting. Work is being performed by Astaldi Construction Corp., with Creative Engineering Group, Inc. administering the construction contract for the Florida Department of Transportation.

Maintenance of Traffic
