Palm Beach County Traffic Report May 20 through May 27, 2016

Palm Beach County – Palm Beach County traffic will be affected this week by ongoing construction projects and maintenance work, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) officials report. **Weather permitting**; closures will be in effect on I-95 and in other areas throughout Palm Beach County for construction activities.

I-95 Corridor Projects:

I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street

Construction on this **1.5-mile project** began **Monday, January 26, 2015,** in the City of Deerfield Beach. Work consists of widening southbound I-95 to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing southbound I-95 exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street, widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane, utility relocation, milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the first of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. The combined project cost for all five projects is an estimated **\$32.5 million.** Work is being performed by **Community Asphalt Corp.** and is expected to be completed **summer 2017.**

Restrictions: The outside lanes of I-95 southbound, between Hillsboro Boulevard and SW 10th Street, will be closed, nightly, with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing 10 p.m. and the third lane, if needed, closing 12:30 a.m., until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. The southbound I-95 exit ramp to SW 10th Street will undergo a full closure, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. Traffic will be detoured via Hillsboro Boulevard. Two lanes of westbound SW 10th Street will be closed, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. The north sidewalk on SW 10th Street, between SW 12th Avenue and SW Natura Boulevard, is closed

completely through August 2016 for construction activities. Pedestrians will be detoured to the south sidewalk; signage is in place to assist. For more information, please contact **Andrea Pacini**, **Public Information Officer**, at 561-214-3358.

I-95 Interchange at Spanish River Boulevard

Construction on this **2.5-mile project** began **Monday, January 13, 2014,** in the City of Boca Raton. Work consists of constructing a new interchange at Spanish River Boulevard and I-95, widening Spanish River Boulevard west of FAU Boulevard, constructing 13 bridges between Spanish River Boulevard and Yamato Road, signalized intersection improvements and the addition of auxiliary lanes on Yamato Road, and sound wall construction along Yamato Road and on the east side of I-95 north of Yamato Road. The project costs an estimated **\$69 million**. The work is being performed by **Astaldi Construction** and is expected to be completed **summer 2017.**

Mainline impacts: I-95 northbound and southbound, between Glades Road and Congress Avenue, may have up to three lanes closed, as needed, nightly, with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., and the second lane and third lanes, if needed, closing 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning. Advanced Notice: I-95 northbound pacing operations are scheduled, nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 7 and Thursday, June 9. FHP will restrict northbound I-95 traffic beginning at SW 10th Street; motorists can expect a half hour delay. The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from westbound and eastbound Glades Road will be closed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 7 and Thursday, June 9, in conjunction with the pacing operation; traffic will be detoured via US-1. I-95 southbound pacing operations are scheduled, nightly, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 14 and Thursday, June 16. FHP will restrict southbound I-95 traffic at Atlantic Avenue; motorists can expect a half hour delay. In conjunction with this operation, the I-95 southbound entrance ramps from westbound and eastbound Yamato Road will be closed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 14 and Thursday, June 16; traffic will be detoured via Congress Avenue.

<u>Ramp impacts:</u> The southbound I-95 entrance ramp from eastbound Yamato Road will be closed nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. The northbound I-95 exit ramp to westbound Yamato Road will be closed nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27.

<u>Yamato Road impacts:</u> Yamato Road, from the southbound I-95 entrance ramp from eastbound Yamato Road, to the northbound I-95 exit ramp to eastbound Yamato Road, will have one outside lane closed in each direction, daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday, May 23 through Friday, May 27.

<u>Trail impacts:</u> The T-Rex Trail is closed through Fall 2016 to facilitate safe construction of the Spanish River Boulevard bridges over I-95. I-95 Interchange Improvements at Woolbright Road

Construction on this **0.354-mile project** began **Monday**, **January 25**, **2016**, in the City of Boynton Beach. Work consists of widening Woolbright Road from SW 18th Street to SW 2nd Street, including roadway approaches and bridges over I-95 and the railroad tracks to provide dual eastbound left turn lanes onto northbound I-95, widening the I-95 northbound entrance ramp to receive the newly constructed dual eastbound left turn lanes, reconstructing the southbound

exit ramp to provide free-flow right turn onto westbound Woolbright Road, retrofitting the railings on the Woolbright Road bridges over I-95 and the railroad to meet current criteria, and milling and resurfacing the entire width of Woolbright Road, and along the I-95 ramps within project limits. Other improvements include utility relocation, bridge construction, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the fourth of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. The combined project cost for all five projects is an estimated \$32.5 million. Work is being performed by Community Asphalt Corp. and is expected to be completed summer 2017.

Restrictions: I-95 southbound, between Boynton Beach Boulevard and West Atlantic Avenue, will be closed, nightly, with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing 10 p.m. and the third lane, if needed, closing 12:30 a.m., until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. Woolbright Road, from SW 8th Street to SW 2nd Street, will have one lane closed in each direction, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. I-95 Interchange at Hypoluxo Road

Construction on this **0.5-mile project** began **Monday, June 22, 2015,** in the Town of Lantana. Work consists of reconfiguring the existing Hypoluxo roadway approaches and bridges over I-95 and the CSX railroad tracks, constructing dual eastbound left turn lanes onto I-95, widening the existing southbound exit ramp to lengthen the turn lanes, retrofitting existing bridge railings to meet current criteria, utility relocation, and installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting and retaining walls. This is the second of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. The combined project cost for all five projects is an estimated **\$32.5 million.** Work is being performed by **Community Asphalt Corp.** and is expected to be completed **summer 2017.**

Restrictions: The outside lanes of I-95 southbound, between Lantana Road and Hypoluxo Road, will be closed, nightly, with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing 10 p.m. and the third lane, if needed, closing 12:30 a.m., until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. The southbound I-95 exit ramp to Hypoluxo Road will undergo a full closure, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. Traffic will be detoured via Lantana Road. The southbound I-95 entrance ramp from Hypoluxo Road will undergo a full closure, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. Traffic will be detoured to Gateway Boulevard via Congress Avenue. Hypoluxo Road, from Seacrest Boulevard to just west of the I-95 southbound exit ramp, will have two lanes closed in each direction, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. I-95 Interchange Improvements at 10th Avenue North

Construction on this **0.579-mile project** began **Monday, November 2, 2015,** in the City of Lake Worth. Work consists of widening 10th Avenue North, from Barnett Drive to "A" Street, including roadway approaches and bridges over I-95 and the railroad tracks to provide dual eastbound turn lanes onto I-95, widening the I-95 northbound entrance ramp to receive the newly constructed dual eastbound left turn lanes, and widening the existing three-lane I-95 southbound exit ramp to four lanes to provide dual left and dual right turns. Other improvements include utility relocation, bridge construction, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls.

This is the third of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. The combined project cost for all five projects is an estimated \$32.5 million. Work is being performed by Community Asphalt Corp. and is expected to be completed summer 2017.

Restrictions: The inside lanes of I-95 northbound and southbound, between Forest Hill Boulevard and 6th Ave., will be closed, nightly, with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing 10 p.m. and the third lane, if needed, closing 12:30 a.m., until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. 10th Avenue North, from Barnett Drive to North A Street, will have two eastbound lanes closed, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27. The south sidewalk on 10th Avenue North, between Barnett Drive and North A Street, is closed completely through December 2016 for construction activities. Pedestrians will be detoured to the north sidewalk; signage is in place to assist. For more information, please contact **Andrea Pacini**, **561-214-3358**.

I-95 Interchange Improvements at Blue Heron Boulevard

Construction on this **1.064-mile project** began **Monday, January 18, 2016,** in the City of Riviera Beach. Work consists of widening the I-95 northbound exit ramp and the I-95 southbound exit to provide an additional left turn lane and new shoulders, lengthening several left turn lanes on Blue Heron Boulevard, from east of Military Trail to Garden Road, and milling and resurfacing the I-95 ramps and Blue Heron Boulevard. Other improvements include upgrades to the drainage structures, guardrail, signalization, signage, and pavement markings, and tree relocations, irrigation repairs, and median repairs. The project cost is an estimated **\$1.2 million.** Work is being performed by **Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc.** and is expected to be completed **summer 2016.**

Restrictions: Blue Heron Boulevard may have one lane closed in each direction, intermittently, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., daily, and 7:30 p.m. until 7 a.m., nightly, Sunday night through Friday morning, through May 2016.

I-95 Interchange Improvements at Donald Ross Road

Construction on this **0.555-mile project** began **Sunday, April 3, 2016,** in the Town of Jupiter. Work consists of widening the I-95 northbound exit ramp and the I-95 southbound exit to accommodate a triple right turn and a triple left turn to eastbound Donald Ross Road, modifying lanes on Donald Ross Road to provide a triple left turn onto the I-95 southbound entrance ramp, widening the southbound entrance ramp to I-95 to accommodate the triple left turn from Donald Ross Road, and removing old asphalt and resurfacing existing pavement. Other improvements include utility relocation, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the fifth of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. The combined project cost for all five projects is an estimated **\$32.5 million.** Work is being performed by **Community Asphalt Corp.** and is expected to be completed **summer 2017.**

Restrictions: Donald Ross Road, from 54th Way North to Heights Boulevard, will have two lanes closed in each direction, nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday, May 22 through Friday morning, May 27, with the first lane closing at 9 p.m. and the second lane closing 10 p.m. For more information, please contact **Andrea Pacini**, 561-214-3358.

Central Palm Beach County Projects:

Forest Hill Boulevard (State Road 882), east of Olive Tree Boulevard to east of Jog Road

Construction on this **0.44-mile project** began **Thursday, May 12, 2016,** in the City of Greenacres. Work includes milling and resurfacing the roadway, ADA upgrades, widening to accommodate for bike lanes, sidewalk reconstruction and upgrades, drainage improvements, and signing and pavement markings. The project cost is an estimated **\$1.3 million**. The work is being performed by **Arc Electric, Inc.,** and is expected to be completed **late summer 2016.**

Restrictions: One lane of Forest Hill Boulevard, from Olive Tree Drive to Jog Road, may be closed in each direction, 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, through June 2016.

Flagler Memorial Bridge Replacement Project

This **0.66-mile Design/Build project** includes replacing the existing bascule (draw) bridge with a new bascule bridge connecting the Town of Palm Beach and the City of West Palm Beach over the Lake Worth Lagoon and the Intracoastal Waterway. The Flagler Drive overpass will be replaced with an "at-grade" intersection. New lighting, pedestrian features, traffic signals, drainage, and landscaping are also included. The Design/Build team for this project is PCL Civil Constructers and Hardesty & Hanover. New Millennium Engineering, Inc. provides Construction Engineering and Inspection services on behalf of FDOT. Active construction began on **Sept. 10**, **2012** and will last until **spring 2017**. The estimated construction cost is **\$100 million**.

Restriction: Flagler Drive is closed in both directions from 4 Street to the Flagler Memorial Bridge around—the—clock until late summer 2016 while workers reconstruct the road in this area. The following detours are in place:

Drivers going north on Flagler Drive from south of 4 Street should:

- Go west on Banyan Boulevard
- Go north on N. Dixie Highway
- Go east on Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard to Flagler Drive

Drivers going south on Flagler Drive from north of the bridge should:

- Go north/south on Flagler Drive to Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard
- Go west on Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard
- Go south on N. Dixie Highway
- Go east on Banyan Boulevard to Flagler Drive

Drivers going west on Flagler Memorial Bridge should:

- Go north on Flagler Drive to Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard
- Go west on Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard
- Go south on N. Dixie Highway
- Go east on Banyan Boulevard to Flagler Drive

Drivers who want to go east on the Flagler Memorial Bridge should access the bridge from N. Quadrille Boulevard.

Marine Restrictions: Full-channel and half-channel closures of the navigable Intracoastal Waterway (ICWW) through the Flagler Memorial Bridge are underway and will continue through July, 2016. These closures are necessary for the contractor to complete building the new bascule (moveable) spans, which are over the ICWW on the replacement bridge. Northern Palm Beach County Projects:

<u>State Road 710/Beeline Highway "Phase C" from Australian Avenue to President Barack Obama Boulevard</u>

This **0.819-mile** widening project began **Monday, January 4, 2016,** in the City of Riviera Beach. Work includes widening the existing roadway from two (2) to four (4) lanes, adding four (4) foot bike lanes and sidewalks, adding a new frontage road for residences, installing median, curb & gutter, and a perimeter wall (in 2 locations), drainage improvements, water and sewer improvements (funded by the City of Riviera Beach), and upgrades to signing and pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. The work is being performed by **JW Cheatham, LLC,** and is expected to be completed **spring 2019.** The estimated construction cost is **\$17.4 million.**

Restrictions: 7th Street at Australian Avenue may have temporary closures for underground utility work, 7 a.m. until 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, through May 2016. Motorists will be able to pass through the work zone during this time. President Barack Obama Boulevard will have one lane closed in each direction, from 4th Street to 7th Street, 8 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. Avenue I, between State Road 710 and 9th Street, is closed to thru traffic through approximately May 2016 for reconstruction. A local access road will be maintained to access locations on the NE corner of 9th Street and Avenue I. All other traffic is being detoured via 9th Street to Avenue J and Avenue H.

<u>Full closure:</u> Beginning Thursday night, June 2, the intersection of State Road 710 and President Barack Obama Highway will undergo a full closure for drainage work through approximately Monday, June 6. Motorists heading northbound and southbound on President Barack Obama Boulevard will be detoured via W. 7th Street and Avenue G. Truck traffic on State Road 710 will have access to the Port of Palm Beach during this time via a temporary roadway located to the north and south of the intersection closure.

<u>State Road 809/Military Trail Lighting Project from Shiloh Drive to State Road 710</u> (Beeline Highway)

This **3-mile** lighting project began **Monday**, **January 11**, **2016**, in the City of Riviera Beach. Work includes lighting improvements along Military Trail, which included installing conduit and performing utility relocations. The work is being performed by **Carr Construction**, and is expected to be completed **fall 2016**. The estimated construction cost is **\$590,397.69**.

Restrictions: One outside lane may be closed in each direction, 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

PGA Boulevard, from State Road 710 to the C-18 Canal

This **1.9-mile** design-build project began **Friday**, **June 19**, **2015**, in the City of Palm Beach Gardens. Work includes designing and raising the existing roadway to create a 2-lane undivided roadway, and construction of a new single span bridge, with new drainage and wildlife crossing. The work is being performed by **Ranger Construction Industries**, **Inc.**, and is expected to be completed **fall 2016**. The estimated construction cost is **\$9.47 million**.

Restrictions: One lane may be closed in each direction, 7 a.m. until 7 p.m., Monday through Friday. Flagmen will be on-site to direct traffic, as needed. Traffic has also been shifted to

temporary outside lanes on the north and south sides of the bridge, to allow for bridge construction in the center portion of the roadway. Traffic will remain in this configuration through approximately August 2016. In order to complete pile driving operations at the new bridge location, Florida Power and Light will shut down transmission lines for approximately 48 hours, with work permitted around the clock beginning Friday night, May 20, through Monday, May 23. Please note, power outages will not affect Sandhill Crane Park or the surrounding communities.

State Road 710 from the Pratt Whitney Entrance to the Palm Beach/Martin County Line
This 6-mile widening and resurfacing project began Monday, October 20, 2014, in the Town of
Jupiter. Work includes design and construction of a four (4) lane divided roadway and median,
installation of new traffic signal at the State Road 710/Indiantown Road intersection, and
lighting, signage, and striping upgrades. The work is being performed by Ranger Construction
Industries, Inc., and is expected to be completed fall 2016. The estimated construction cost is
\$21.9 million.

Restrictions: One lane of traffic is open in each direction through fall 2016, while the contractor removes and rebuilds the existing roadway.

Western Palm Beach County Projects:

State Road 80 Bridge Rehabilitation, #930354 & #930355 just east of State Road 700
This 0.44-mile bridge rehabilitation project began Wednesday, July 29, 2015, in the Town of Loxahatchee. Work includes replacing the current bridge structure with reinforced concrete deck, Class V finish, and drainage installation along the length of the bridge. The work is being performed by Morrison-Cobalt JV, and is expected to be completed fall 2016. The estimated construction cost is \$2.2 million.

Restrictions: The outside lanes are open in each direction on both newly constructed bridges, with the inside lanes closed to allow for median work. Traffic will remain in this configuration through June 2016.

State Road 715, from State Road 717 to State Road 15 (US 441)

This **9.974-mile** improvement project began **Monday**, **January 25**, **2016**, in the City of Belle Glade and the City of Pahokee. Work includes milling and resurfacing the roadway, minor shoulder and roadway reconstruction, new sidewalk and guardrail installation, and signal, signage, and pavement marking improvements. The work is being performed by **Community Asphalt Corporation**, and is expected to be completed **fall 2016**. The estimated construction cost is **\$7.6 million**.

Restrictions: One lane may be closed in each direction, intermittently, approximately two (2) miles south and north of Hooker Highway, 7 a.m. until 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

State Road 25/US 27 Intersection Improvements at State Road 80 in South Bay
This 0.368-mile improvement project began Monday, April 4, 2016, in the City of South Bay.
Work includes widening, milling and resurfacing a merge lane after the State Road 80
westbound to State Road 25 northbound bypass, extending the median left turn lane length for the State Road 80 intersection, and curb and gutter, sidewalk, landscaping, signing, pavement marking, and intersection improvements. The work is being performed by Jones Benitez Corp,

and is expected to be completed **early summer 2016.** The estimated construction cost is \$593,860.

Restrictions: US 27 may have one lane closed in each direction, daily, Monday through Saturday. State Road 80 may have one westbound lane closed, daily, Monday through Saturday.

Maintenance, Utility and Permit Closures:

Restrictions: Florida Power and Light (FPL) will be replacing a fiber crossing on I-95, just south of Central Boulevard in the Town of Jupiter, Friday night, May 20. Florida Highway Patrol Officers will slow traffic on I-95 northbound beginning at Southern Boulevard, and on I-95 southbound beginning at Kanner Highway, between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. The pacing operations will last approximately 20 minutes, intermittently. Restrictions: Lake Worth Road at Congress Avenue, in Lake Worth, will have the southbound outside turn lane closed, 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 23, for paving operations.

Restrictions: The two outside lanes of eastbound Southern Boulevard, from Sansbury Way to west of Benoist Farms Road, in West Palm Beach, will be closed, 2 a.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday morning, May 24, for paving operations. In conjunction with this closure, Benoist Farms Road south of the Southern Boulevard intersection may have traffic shifted slightly to allow for paving operations.

Restrictions: The northbound outside lane of Powerline Road, from north of Town Harbour Boulevard to south of Palmetto Park Road, in the City of Boca Raton, will be closed, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Wednesday, May 25, for overhead maintenance repairs.

Restrictions: US 1, from McClaren Road to Palmetto Drive, in the Village of North Palm Beach, may have daily intermittent lane closures in the southbound lanes, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., for Florida Power and Light (FPL) power line pole replacement. Work will last through June 2016. For more information, please call 1-800-693-3267, and refer to the "Landings-Riviera T12650 Pole Replacement Project."

Restrictions: The eastbound outside lane of Palmetto Park Road at State Road 7 (US 441), at the E-1 Canal Bridge west of the City of Boca Raton, will be closed through approximately August 2016 for bridge sidewalk improvements. Pedestrians will not have access to the south side of the bridge during this time. For more information, **please contact Palm Beach County Engineering at 561-684-4000.**

Restrictions: The PGA Boulevard Bridge, over the Intracoastal Waterway in the City of Palm Beach Gardens, will have the westbound inside lane closed, 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 23, Wednesday, May 25, and Thursday, May 26, for work order repairs.

Restrictions: Donald Ross Road, from east of I-95 to Central Boulevard, in the City of Palm Beach Gardens and the Town of Jupiter, may have daily lane closures for road improvements. For more information, **please contact Palm Beach County Engineering at 561-684-4000.**

Restrictions: Military Trail, from Donald Ross Road to Indiantown Road, in the Town of Jupiter, may have daily lane closures for pavement marking installation. For more information, **please contact Palm Beach County Engineering at 561-684-4000.**

Restrictions: Military Trail and Burns Road, in the City of Palm Beach Gardens, may have daily lane closures for road widening and mast arm installation. For more information, **please contact Palm Beach County Engineering at 561-684-4000.**
