Bridge Work for I-95 Widening at Camino Real to Begin Tuesday, August 1, 2018

Bridge construction activities for the widening of I-95 at Camino Real in Boca Raton will begin August 2018. Current scheduling shows the contractor mobilizing equipment to this area July 2—13, with construction beginning Tuesday, August 1.

As part of the bridge widening operation at this location, pile driving will occur. This activity, pictured below, can create noise. Permitted construction times are 7 a.m. until 6 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 8 a.m. until 7 p.m. on Saturdays. No work is permitted on Sundays or holidays. FDOT estimates that pile driving will be completed within two months, weather permitting. Bridge construction crews will be on site at this location through Summer 2019.



This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of SW 10th Street to south of Glades Road in Broward and Palm Beach counties, to include two Managed Lanes in each direction. Scope of work includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes, reconstruction of the Hillsboro Canal Bridge, bridge widenings at Palmetto Park Road and Camino Real, construction of a northbound and southbound auxiliary lane between Hillsboro Boulevard and Palmetto Park Road, construction of a northbound auxiliary lane between the SW 10th Street entrance ramp and Hillsboro Boulevard exit ramp, guardrail, barrier wall, drainage, landscape relocation, and ITS installation.
