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FDOT Broward County Traffic Report October 19, 2018 through October 26, 2018

FORT LAUDERDALE -- Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the week of October 19 through October 26, 2018. Weather permitting, work will be done at the following locations throughout the county.

Interstate 95

1. I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale Traffic Impact:

- I-95 will have three lanes closed in each direction Sunday through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first two lanes will close at 9 p.m., the third lane at 10 p.m. and the fourth lane at 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- I-95 in both directions, from south of Davie Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard, will have intermittent shoulder and ramp shoulder closures, as needed, daily and nightly.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Cypress Creek Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed, nightly, as needed, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard and Powerline Road.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will have one inside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Sunrise Boulevard will be closed between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Broward Boulevard will be closed as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via the Broward Boulevard Park & Ride lot and I-95 northbound. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramps to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound Oakland Park Boulevard will have one inside lane closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, through December.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Commercial Boulevard will be closed as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday night, beginning Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, November 1. Traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road, Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday night, beginning Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, November 1. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. * Please note that consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.
- Commercial Boulevard will have two eastbound lanes closed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday night, beginning Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, November 1.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard to south of SW 10th Street in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment, ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps at Davie Road, Broward Boulevard, Sunrise Boulevard, Oakland Park Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard, widening bridges, and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 southbound north of Sample Road. Contract time for this \$149 million project began Sunday, October 4, 2015. Construction began Sunday, August 21, 2016. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$150 million. Completion is expected in summer 2020.

2. I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10th Street will have three lanes closed in each direction Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Copans Road between North Andrews Avenue and North Dixie Highway will be closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- One lane in each direction of Cypress Creek Road will be closed daily, 9 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.
- Copans Road at I-95 will undergo a full closure for bridge construction, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Westbound traffic will be detoured via I-95 northbound and Sample Road. Eastbound traffic will be detoured via I-95 southbound and Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to eastbound Copans Road will be closed, as needed for paving, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to westbound Copans Road will be closed, as needed for paving, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and East Atlantic Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Copans Road will be closed, as needed for paving, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Copans Road will be closed, as needed for paving, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via N. Andrews Avenue, I-95 and Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to eastbound Sample Road will be closed, as needed for paving, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Copans Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Sample Road will be closed, as needed for paving, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via N. Andrews Road and Copans Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- *Please note that consecutive ramps won't be closed at the same time.
- **I-95 Northbound Full Closure Advanced Notice:** I-95 northbound lanes at Sample Road will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Wednesday night, October 24 and Thursday night, October 25, and Tuesday night, October 30 if needed, for new bridge construction. Motorists will be detoured via the I-95 northbound exit ramp to Sample Road, S. Dixie Highway and SW 10th Street. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. - **I-95 Southbound Full Closure Advanced Notice:** I-95 southbound lanes at SW 10th Street will be closed to traffic overnight, 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday night, October 28, Monday night, October 29 and Tuesday night, October 30 if needed, for new bridge construction. Motorists will be detoured via the I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street, Military Trail, and Sample Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists. - **Long-term Full Closure Notice:** The Park & Ride entrance from the eastbound exit ramp to Cypress Creek Road is closed completely, reopening 5 a.m., Monday morning, November 5. Traffic will be detoured east along Cypress Creek Road to a U-Turn at NE 7th Ave/Corporate Drive, and then west along Cypress Creek Road to the Park and Ride.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard to south of SW 10th Street in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment, ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps at Andrews Avenue, Cypress Creek Road and Atlantic Boulevard, widening bridges and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 southbound north of Sample Road. Contract time for this \$154 million project began Friday, January 8, 2016. Construction began Sunday, August 14, 2016. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$154 million. Completion is expected in fall 2019.

3. I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street

Traffic Impact:

- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street will be fully closed, as needed, Sunday night through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists can detour via Hillsboro Boulevard.
- The outside lanes of I-95 southbound from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street will be closed Sunday night through Thursday night with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing at 10 p.m. and the third lane, if necessary, closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m.
- Two westbound lanes of SW 10th Street at I-95 will be closed Sunday night through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- The sidewalk on the north side of SW 10th Street between SW 12th Avenue and SW Natura Boulevard is closed through November 2018. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk.

Description: Construction on this 1.5-mile project began Monday, January 26, 2015. Work consists of widening southbound I-95 to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing southbound I-95 exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street, widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane, utility relocation, milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the first of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Cost/Completion: Construction cost for all five projects is \$32.5 million. Completion in fall 2018.

4. I-95 from south of SW 10th Street to south of Glades Road (95 Express Phase 3B-1)

Traffic Impacts:

- **I-95 traffic impacts:** I-95 will have three lanes closed in each direction nightly, as needed, between Hillsboro Boulevard and Palmetto Park Road, with the first lane closing at 9:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 10:30 p.m., and the third lane closing at 11:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, through November.
- **Camino Real traffic impacts:** Camino Real between SW 15th Avenue and SW 19th Avenue has one outside lane closed in each direction through mid-December.
- **Palmetto Park Road traffic impacts:**
 - Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have the eastbound inside ramp lane to I-95 northbound closed through March 2019.
 - Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have the westbound inside lane closed through March 2019; the existing westbound ramp lane to I-95 southbound will be converted to a thru/ramp lane.
 - Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have two lanes closed in each direction nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday, through December. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., and the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m. All lanes will be opened by 6 a.m.
 - Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have one lane closed in each direction daily, as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 3 p.m., Monday through Friday, through December.
 - Palmetto Park Road at I-95 will have all westbound lanes closed, 11 p.m. until 4 a.m., Sunday night, Oct. 21 and Monday night, Oct. 22. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Glades Road.
- **Ramp Impacts:**
 - The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Hillsboro Boulevard will be closed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Wednesday, Oct. 24. Traffic will be detoured via Military Trail and Palmetto Park Road. For more information, please contact Community Outreach Specialist Andrea Pacini 561-214-3358.

Description: This 4.8-mile project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of SW 10th Street to south of Glades Road in Broward and Palm Beach counties. The scope of work includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes which will result in two tolled Express Lanes in each direction; the number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other activities include reconstruction of I-95 on the northbound and southbound approaches to the Hillsboro Canal bridges, milling and resurfacing of I-95, construction of northbound and southbound auxiliary lanes between Hillsboro Boulevard and Palmetto Park Road, and construction of a northbound auxiliary lane between the SW 10th Street entrance ramp and the Hillsboro Boulevard exit ramp. Other project improvements include: guardrail, barrier wall, attenuators, shoulder gutters, drainage, dredging of Hillsboro Canal, bridge widenings at Palmetto Park Road and Camino Real, bridge replacement at Hillsboro Canal, temporary and permanent retaining walls, noise wall construction, sign structures, portable traffic monitoring sites, toll gantry installation, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, ramp signaling at the I-95 entrance ramps from Palmetto Park Road, signing and pavement markings; Express Lane markers, lighting, ramp metering signals, utility relocation, and landscape relocation. Contract time for this \$102 million project began Monday, July 10, 2017, with design and construction activities currently underway. Cost/Completion: Construction began Friday, January 19, 2018. Work is being performed by Prince Contracting, LLC and is expected to be completed spring 2022.

- One ramp lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange will be closed Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to the I-75 Interchange may be closed Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 Interchange to Okeechobee Road may be closed Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to NW 170 Street will be closed nightly Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to Florida's Turnpike on-ramp will be closed Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miramar Parkway will be closed Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed nightly Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of I-75 from NW 170 Street to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25. The northbound lane will be closed from 8 p.m. to 4 p.m., and the southbound lane will be closed from 10 a.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Snake Creek Canal may be closed 9 p.m. Friday, October 5 until 6 a.m. Saturday, October 6.
- One ramp lane in each direction of I-75 at Florida's Turnpike may be closed Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One northbound ramp lane of Florida's Turnpike to northbound I-75 may be closed 9 p.m. Sunday, October 14 until 6 a.m. Thursday, October 18.
- One lane in each direction of I-75 at Florida's Turnpike may be closed Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Three southbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Florida's Turnpike will be closed nightly 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday, October 12 through Thursday, October 18.
- All southbound lanes of I-75 between Miramar Parkway and Bass Creek Bridge will be closed 11 p.m. Wednesday, October 24 until 5 a.m. Thursday, October 25. During this time, motorists wishing to travel southbound on I-75 between Miramar Parkway and Bass Creek Bridge will be detoured to exit at Miramar Parkway East (Exit 7), continue east on Miramar Parkway to Red Road, south on Red Road to NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive, and west on NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive to take the southbound entrance ramp to I-75. - All southbound lanes on I-75 between Miramar Parkway and Bass Creek Bridge will be closed 11 p.m. Wednesday, October 24 to 5 a.m. Thursday, October 25. During this time, motorists wishing to travel southbound on I-75 between Miramar Parkway and Bass Creek Bridge will be detoured to exit at Miramar Parkway East (Exit 7), continue east on Miramar Parkway to Red Road, south on Red Road to NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive, and west on NW 183 Street/Miami Gardens Drive to take the southbound entrance ramp to I-75.

595 Express

6. All I 595 Express Lane Shoulders going Eastbound will be closed intermittently every day 4:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and Westbound will be closed intermittently every day from 2:00pm to 2:00am from Monday,

October 1, 2018 to Tuesday, November 13, 2018 for Installation of Fire Suppression System Guardrails.

7. Broward Boulevard Improvements and Bridge Replacement Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- All lanes open through Friday, October 26.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the bridge over the North Fork of the New River, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading signs and pavement markings, relocating bus shelters, adding roadway lighting, installing drainage structures, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, reconstructing sidewalks, and widening roadway to add bike lanes in each direction. - One lane southbound lane along 4 Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale from NE 12 Avenue to NE 11 Avenue will be permanently closed for median relocation.
- One lane northbound lane along 4 Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale at NE 16 Avenue will be temporarily permanently closed for the installation of drainage structures through the end of the month.

- One lane southbound lane of SR 811 / NE 4 Avenue / Wilton Drive from NE 26 Street to NE 11 Avenue will be temporarily permanently closed through the end of the month.
- The righthand turn lane will be closed at North Dixie Highway and NE 26 Street will be temporarily permanently closed through the end of the month.
- NE 26 Street and Wilton Drive will be permanently closed.
- NE 11 Avenue will be permanently closed on both sides of Wilton Drive.
- The sidewalk on the east side of SR 811 / NE 4 Avenue / Wilton Drive between NE 21 Avenue to NE 6 Avenue will be temporarily permanently closed for the installation of drainage structures through the end of the month.
- The sidewalk on the SE corner of NE 20 St and Wilton Drive will be temporarily permanently closed for the installation of curb bulb-outs through Friday.
- The sidewalk on the SE corner of NE 16 Street and NE 4 Avenue will be temporarily permanently closed for the installation of two drainage structures through the end of the month.
