GAINES AVENUE MEDIAN CLOSURE EXTENDED THROUGH FEB. 26

The median opening along Kanner Highway at Gaines Avenue is closed through Monday evening, February 26 at 5 p.m., weather permitting, to facilitate drainage work.

Motorists heading north on Kanner Highway wanting to turn onto Gaines Avenue should continue north and U-turn at the median opening near RaceTrac. Motorists wanting to make a left turn from Gaines Avenue onto Kanner Highway should head south on Kanner Highway and U-turn at Cove Road.



This work is part of the Kanner Highway widening project from Lost River Road to south of Monterey Road. Work on this project includes: widening Kanner Highway from a four-lane divided highway to a six-lane divided highway; widening the bridge over the South Fork St. Lucie River; drainage improvements, including construction of five retention ponds; construction of sound walls at Fisherman's / Somerset Cove and Whitemarsh Reserve; guardrail improvements; signalization upgrades; and turn lane and bicycle lane improvements.
