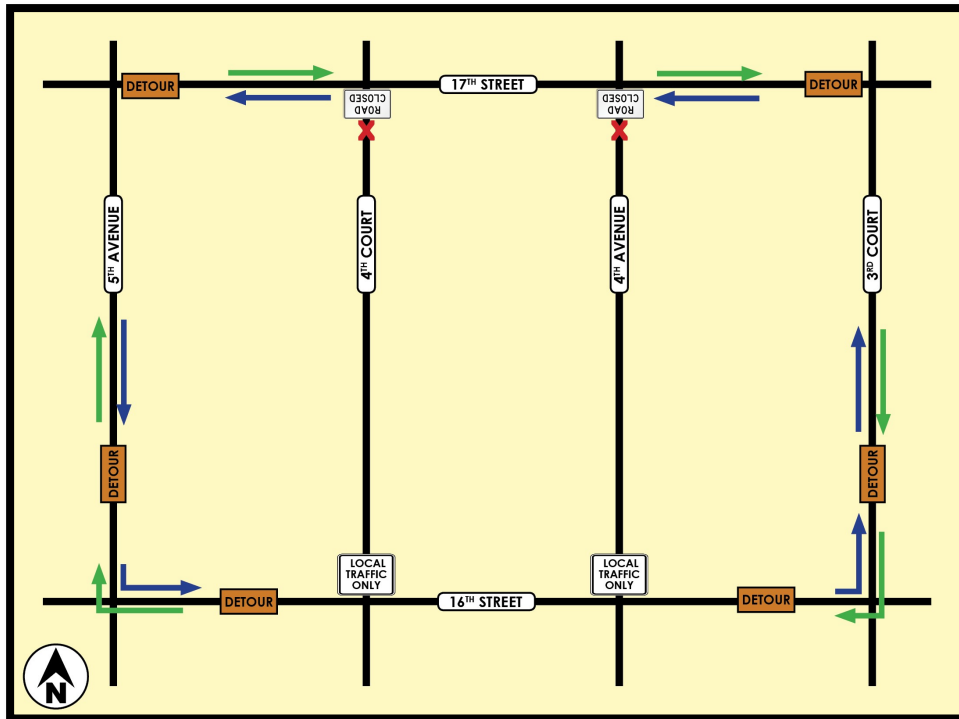
17th Street (SR 656) Shoulder Widening & Resurfacing Project

From U.S. 1 to the 17th Street Causeway Bridge

Full Closures at 4th Court & 4th Avenue, May 7 - May 18

Starting Monday morning, May 7 at 7 a.m., 4th Court and 4th Avenue in the City of Vero Beach will be closed just south of 17th Street for drainage work. This closure is anticipated to be in place through May 18, 2018, weather permitting. Motorists should detour via 3rd Court or 5th Avenue to 16th Street (see detour below).



This drainage work is part of the 17th Street shoulder widening and resurfacing project from U.S. 1 to the 17th Street Causeway Bridge in the City of Vero Beach. The improvements under this contract consist of widening the shoulder along 17th Street from U.S. 1 to 17th Street Causeway Bridge to accommodate 6.5 feet average wide buffered bike lanes in both directions; drainage, sidewalk and detectable warning surfaces; signalization improvements including installing a new mast arm at the NW corner of 6th Avenue, and upgrading pedestrian detectors; milling & resurfacing existing lanes; and striping improvements.
