- Upgrading sidewalk and pedestrian ramps
- Upgrading signs and pavement markings
- Upgrading pedestrian signal heads at three signalized intersections

Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the travelling public. Single and double lane closures will occur Sunday through Thursday night from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

From I-95: Take I-95 to the SR 76/Kanner Highway exit and head east, take a right on SE Cove Road, a left on A1A, turn right onto SE Anchor Avenue and you will see the Port Salerno Civic Center on the left.

From the FL Turnpike: Take the Stuart exit (Exit 133), travel east via Martin Highway. Take a right on Old Dixie Highway, turn left onto SE Anchor Avenue and you will see the Port Salerno Civic Center on the left.
