CR 612/8th Street over Lateral Canal C (Bridge No. 884024) Bridge Replacement Project

Indian River County, as project sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) design and construct the CR 612/8th Street over Lateral Canal C (Bridge No. 884024) Bridge Replacement Project, through Indian River County Resolution 2018-039. FDOT is pleased to assist with completing these improvements.

Construction Cost: \$6.9 million

Construction Start: June 2023

Estimated Completion: Spring 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing the existing two-lane bridge (No. 884024) over Lateral Canal C
- Dredging Lateral Canal C to accommodate new bridge construction
- Installing guardrail to shield the canal hazards
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Full closure of the CR 612/8th Street and 74th Avenue intersection to facilitate construction activities. Detours are as follows:
 - Eastbound CR 612/8th Street motorists will be detoured via 82nd Avenue, 16th Street and 66th Avenue to CR 612/8th Street
 - Westbound CR 612/8th Street motorists will be detoured via 66th Avenue, 16th Street and 82nd Avenue to CR 612/8th Street
 - Northbound 74th Avenue motorists will be detoured via 4th Street, 66th Avenue and 16th Street to 74th Avenue
 - Southbound 74th Avenue motorists will be detoured via 16th Street, 66th Avenue and 4th Street to 74th Avenue
- Business and residential access will be maintained at all times.
