Please visit www.d4fdot.com for information on FDOT construction projects in the Treasure Coast. n Wednesday, July 12, 2017, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the I-95 bridge deck replacement project over Glades Cut Off Road (County Road 709) & the FEC Railroad at approximate mile marker 125 in the City of Port St. Lucie and over Ten Mile Creek (just south of Okeechobee Road / Exit 129).

The Open House will be held from 4 PM until 6 PM at the St. Lucie County Fire District Administration Complex, 5160 NW Milner Drive, Port St. Lucie, FL 34983. Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, construction schedule, and address questions and comments one-on-one. No formal presentation will be made.

This project is expected to begin July 10, 2017, and is anticipated to be completed by summer 2019, weather permitting. The cost for construction is \$13.46 million. Work will be performed by Lead Engineering Contractors, with FDOT and Cardno overseeing the project.

Scope of Work:

- Replacing the bridge decks on I-95 over Glades Cut Off Road (CR 709) & the FEC Railroad and over Ten Mile Creek (just south of Okeechobee Road / Exit 129)
- Milling and resurfacing approaches to bridge decks
- Re-striping approaches to bridge decks

Maintenance of Traffic:

To facilitate the replacement of these bridge decks, I-95 will be reduced from three lanes to two lanes in each direction at the two overpasses — Glades Cutoff Road (CR 709) and Ten Mile Creek. The speed limit on I-95 at these two locations will be reduced from 70 MPH to 60 MPH for the duration of this project.

Nighttime lane closures on I-95 will occur Sunday through Thursday between the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. Daytime & nighttime lane closures will occur on Glades Cutoff Road (CR 709) without any time restrictions. When work is occurring on the I-95 bridge decks over travel lanes, two-way traffic will be maintained by a flag crew at all times.
