

## **McCarty Road North Bridge Replacement Project**

## OPEN HOUSE JULY 27, 2017

n Thursday, July 27, 2017, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the McCarty Road North Bridge replacement project over Ten Mile Creek.

The Open House will be held from 4 p.m. until 6 p.m. at the Project Team Field Office, 2552 Peters Road, Suite C, Fort Pierce, Florida 34950. Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, construction schedule, and address questions and comments one-on-one. <u>Please note</u>: There will not be a formal presentation. Guests may arrive at any time between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.

This 0.12-mile project is expected to begin July 31, 2017, and is anticipated to be completed by spring 2018, weather permitting. The cost for construction is \$1,472,241.75. Work will be performed by Morrison-Cobalt JV, with FDOT and Cardno overseeing the project.

## Scope of Work:

- Replacing the McCarty Road Bridge over Ten-Mile Creek, raising the bridge approximately 2 feet above the existing bridge elevation to better accommodate flood creek water elevations. The new bridge configuration will be a two-lane undivided road with 12' lanes, outside shoulders, and a sidewalk on the east side of the bridge
- Replacing both approach slabs
- Roadway reconstruction and widening immediately north and south of the new bridge
- Drainage improvements including new inlets and installation of a French-drain system and providing slope protection/channel lining below the bridge to prevent erosion
- Installing signing and pavement markings

## Maintenance of Traffic:

To replace the bridge, McCarty Road (County Road 712A) will undergo a **full around-the-clock closure** from Twin Creeks Drive north for 0.12 miles. **This full closure is expected to begin the week of July 31, 2017, and is anticipated to last for approximately 9 months, weather permitting.** During this time, motorists should detour via Okeechobee Road or Midway Road to Shin Road (see detour graphic).
