On Wednesday, July 26, 2017, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informational Open House for the State Road A1A & Sewall's Point Road signalization project in the Town of Sewall's Point.

The Open House will be held from 4:00 PM until 6:00 PM at Sewall's Point Town Hall in the Commission Chambers, One South Sewall's Point Road, Sewall's Point, FL 34496. Project personnel will be on hand to discuss the scope of work, construction schedule, and address questions and comments one-on-one. No formal presentation will be made.

This project is expected to begin August 11, 2017, with anticipated completion by early 2018, weather permitting. The cost for construction is \$459,999.69. Work will be performed by ARC Electric, Inc., with FDOT overseeing the project.

Scope of Work:

- Upgrade signalization by installing new mast arms, pedestrian detectors, and closed-circuit television
- Sidewalk and driveway improvements
- Minor landscaping on State Road A1A (NE Ocean Boulevard) at the intersection of Sewall's Point Road

Maintenance of Traffic:

Work will be done in phases to minimize traffic impacts. Lane closures will occur at the intersection during non-peak hours. The speed limit on State Road A1A at the intersection will be reduced from 40 MPH to 35 MPH for the duration of this project.

Sidewalk closures at the intersection quadrants will occur to accommodate mast arm installation, closing only one section at a time.
