This drainage work is part of the Midway Road widening project from just west of South 25th Street to just east of U.S. 1. Work on this project includes: reconstructing the existing two-lane Midway Road to a four-lane, divided highway with a raised median; installing a new signal at Sunrise Boulevard; constructing a new bridge over the North Fork St. Lucie River; constructing a 6-foot sidewalk on the north side and a 12-foot multi-purpose trail on the south side Midway Road; constructing 4-foot bike lanes on both sides of the roadway; reconstruction of S. 25th Street, Sunrise Boulevard, and Oleander Avenue at their respective Midway Road intersections; drainage improvements, including constructing 6 retention ponds at 5 locations; and signage, signalization, and lighting improvements.
