



Indrio Road (SR 614) Widening Project

FM#: 230338-4-52-01 From W. of the I-95 Interchange to E. of Emerson Ave./SR 607

Full Closure on Johnston Rd. North of Indrio Rd. Through Dec. 22

Johnston Road just north of Indrio Road is closed around-the-clock to facilitate roadway reconstruction. The work necessitating this full closure is anticipated to be completed by no later than December 22, 2017, weather permitting. During this time, motorists should detour via Oslo Road or Indrio Road to Emerson Avenue (see detour graphic).

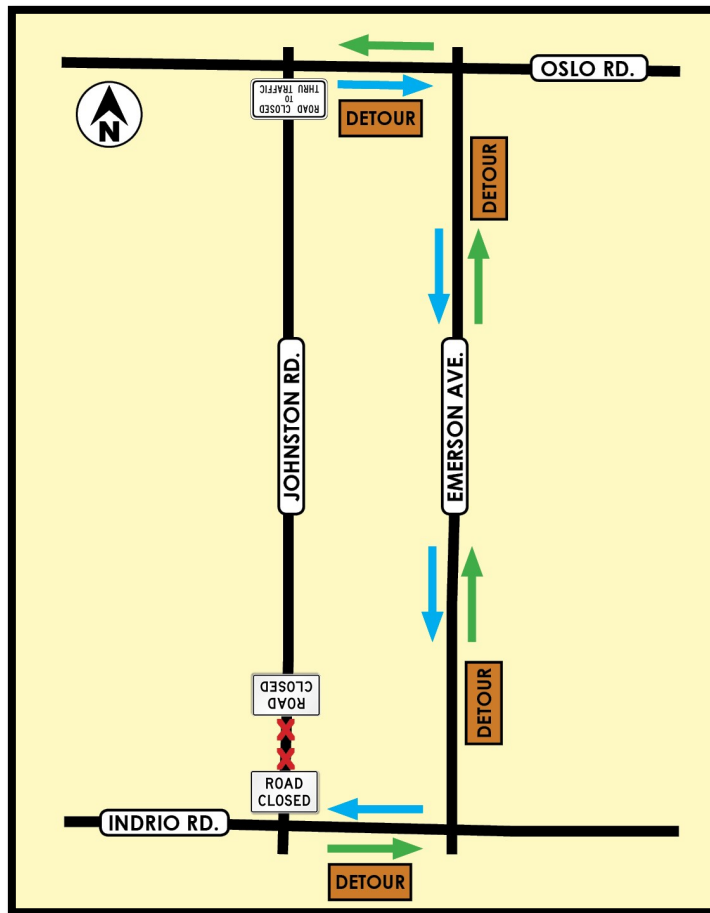

This work is part of the \$23.95 million Indrio Road widening project from west of the I-95 interchange to east of Emerson Avenue (State Road 607). Work on this project includes: reconstructing the existing two-lane Indrio Road to a four-lane, divided highway with a raised median; constructing a 6-foot sidewalk along the south side and a 12-foot-wide multi-purpose trail along the north side of Indrio Road; realigning Spanish Lakes Boulevard to connect with Koblebard Road; reconstructing Koblebard Road from Indrio Road north approximately .5 mile; and installing new highway lighting, signage and signalization. This project is anticipated to be completed in spring 2019.
