

**I-95/State Road 9 Widening, from just north of State Road 60
to the Indian River/Brevard County Line**

Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) started final design in May with construction expected to begin August 2013 to add one general purpose lane in each direction on the existing median throughout the project limits, along with milling/resurfacing of the existing pavement; removal and replacement of the existing bridges over County Road (CR) 512; construction of a noise barrier wall adjacent to the Encore Sunshine Travel RV Resort; and reconstruction of the interchange at CR 512; including ramps, turn lanes, signalization and lighting improvements. The project also includes relocating or replacing existing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Dynamic Message Signs (DMS) and cameras.

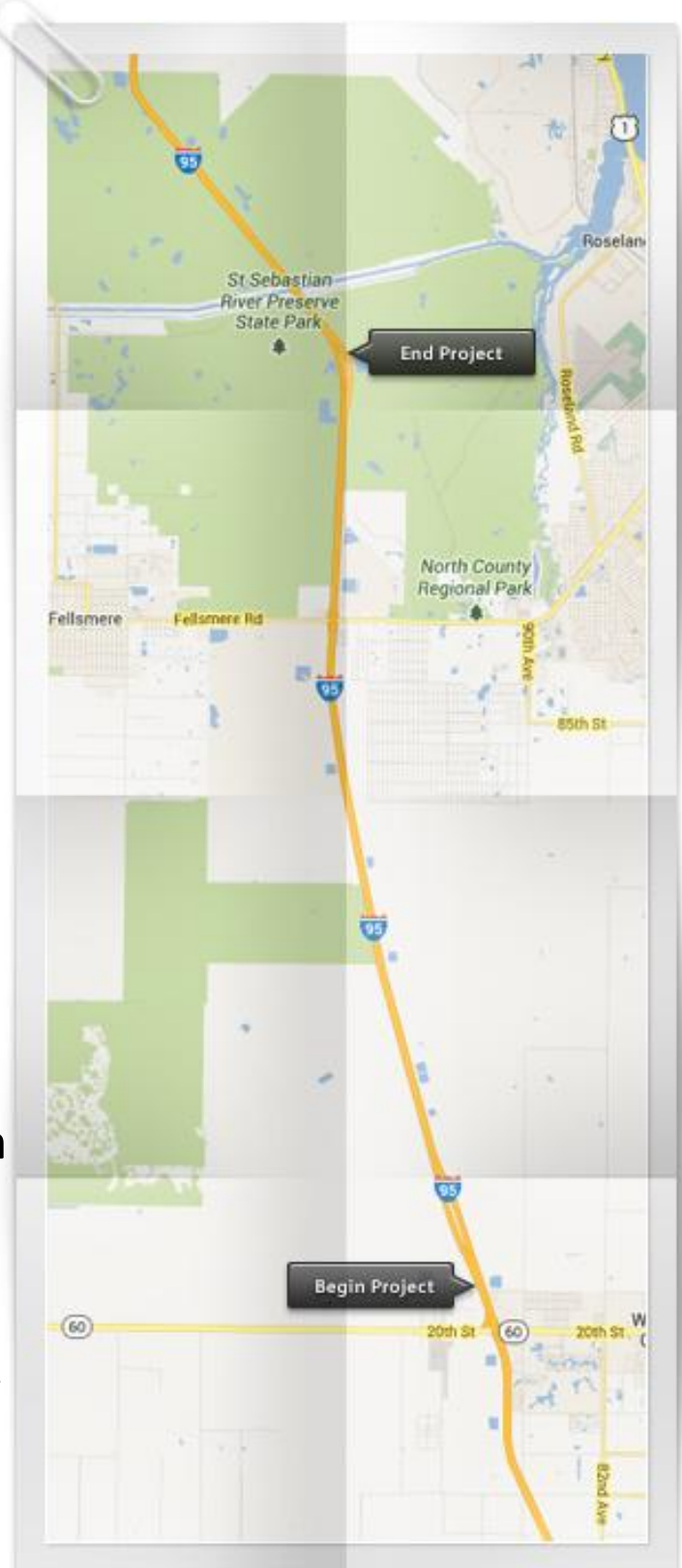

What to Expect During Construction

Motorists are advised to use caution and watch for construction workers in the construction zone.

All lanes will be maintained during day time hours. Nighttime lane closures may occur during non-peak hours (from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, with the exception of Holidays and Special Event Days in which no lane closures will occur.) Lane closures are prohibited from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Friday and Saturday. Electronic signs will provide a two-week advance notice of upcoming lane closures.
