## SR A1A/South Ocean Boulevard Resurfacing Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites you to a Virtual Public Meeting and an In-person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming resurfacing project on State Road (SR) A1A/South Ocean Boulevard from south of Grand Court to south of Linton Boulevard in the Town of Highland Beach and the City of Delray Beach. Construction Cost: \$8.3 million

Construction Start: April 2024

Anticipated Completion: Summer 2025

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Mill and resurface the existing roadway.
- Widen the roadway in each direction to provide five-foot bicycle lanes.
- Modify swales to improve drainage.
- Upgrade signing and pavement markings to meet current standards.

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public.
- Lane closures are allowed Monday through Sunday from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. during active construction.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place and flagging operations will be used to direct traffic.
- No lane closures are permitted within 500 feet of the St. Lucy Catholic Church driveways on Sunday between 6:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
