City of Boynton Beach Sidewalk and Bicycle Lane Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming City of Boynton Beach Sidewalk and Bicycle Lane Improvements Project in the City of Boynton Beach. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$7.2 million

Construction Start: May 2024

Estimated Completion: End of 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling, resurfacing, and reconstructing SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard within the project limits
- Expanding the existing sidewalk on the south side of SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard to 15 feet and to 9 feet on the north side
- Performing drainage modifications to accommodate sidewalk expansion on SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard
- Retrofitting pedestrian lighting at signalized intersections on SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard
- Constructing a new pedestrian crossing at NW 3rd Street and SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard
- Installing shared lane bicycle markings (sharrows) in each direction of SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard and on West Ocean Avenue
- Upgrading pedestrian signals, pavement markings, and signs

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public.
- One lane in each direction will be closed on SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard and flagging operations will be used to direct traffic.
- One lane in each direction will be closed on West Ocean Avenue.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place on SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard.
- Driveway, business, and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
