NIGHTLY FULL CLOSURE OF U.S. 1/S.R. 5 FOR OVERHEAD SIGN INSTALLATION NOV. 12 & 13, 2025

To ensure community and public safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, northbound and southbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5 from north of Avenue O to Old U.S. Highway 1, will be closed to traffic nightly, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Wednesday, Nov. 12 and Thursday, Nov. 13, for overhead sign installation. Signage will be in place to direct motorists. Sunday, Nov. 16 through Thursday, Nov. 20 will be used as contingency nights if needed.

- Northbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5 motorists will be detoured via westbound Avenue M, northbound S.R. 615/N 25th Street, onto westbound Juanita Avenue to U.S. 1/S.R. 5.
- Southbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5 motorists will be detoured via westbound Juanita Avenue, southbound S.R. 615/N 25th Street, onto eastbound Avenue M to U.S. 1/S.R. 5.
- Old U.S. Highway 1 residents will be detoured via Sunny Lane.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
