Tree Removal Along Taft Street from SR 7/US 441 to N 40th Street Begins February 2025

This notice is to inform you that the FDOT contractor will begin removing select trees from public right-of-way along the north side of Taft Street **beginning February 2025**, as part of the SR 7/US 441 Transit Corridor Improvements Project (Group 9). These trees will be removed to construct of a shared-use path to enhance safety and connectivity for the community. **Residents should remove any items from public right-of-way that may conflict with the new shared-use path.** Lane closures along Taft Street are permitted 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Access to residential properties will be maintained at all times.

The City of Hollywood, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the improvements along Taft Street from SR 7/US 441 to N 40th Street through the City of Hollywood Resolution No. 2021-280. ***The City of Hollywood will be installing new trees as part of a separate contract once this FDOT project in complete.
