



To ensure community and public safety, Floranada Road/NE 45<sup>th</sup> Street from NE 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue to NE 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed in each direction, from 7:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., on Saturday, October 11 for drainage operations. Traffic will be detoured via NE 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue, NE 43<sup>rd</sup> Court and NE 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Signage will be in place to assist motorists. Saturday, October 18 will be used as a contingency day if needed.
