SOUTHBOUND S.R. 9/I-95 AT S.R. 838/SUNRISE BLVD TO CLOSE TUESDAY NIGHT, NOV. 18

All lanes of southbound S.R. 9/I-95 at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed to traffic, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday, Nov. 18. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely install signalization conduits below the S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard Bridge Deck.

During the full closure, southbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the exit ramp to westbound S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard, southbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7, and eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 to access the S.R. 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp.

To ensure motorists and crew safety, the ingress to the S.R. 9/I-95 southbound managed lanes at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. Motorists may enter the managed lanes at the S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard ingress. Wednesday, Nov. 19 will be used as a contingency night if needed.

The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area.
