SOUTHBOUND SR 9/I-95 AT SR 838/SUNRISE BLVD TO CLOSE NIGHTLY SUNDAY, AUG. 17 THROUGH THURSDAY, AUG. 21

All lanes of southbound SR 9/I-95 at SR 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, Aug. 17 through Thursday, Aug. 21. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely begin bridge deck saw cut and removal.

During the full closure, southbound SR 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the exit ramp to westbound SR 838/Sunrise Boulevard, southbound Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, and eastbound SR 842/Broward Boulevard to access the SR 9/I -95 southbound entrance ramp.

To ensure motorists and crew safety, the ingress to the SR 9/I-95 southbound managed lanes at SR 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. Motorists may enter the managed lanes at the SR 842/Broward Boulevard ingress.

The **Florida Highway Patrol (FHP)** will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area.
