

# FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LANE CLOSURE NOTICE

State Road (SR) A1A/South Ocean Boulevard Drainage Improvements Project From Sherman Street to SR 822/Sheridan Street, from Franklin Street to Walnut Street, and from Crocus Terrace to Van Buren Street In the City of Hollywood Broward County, FL

#### SR 822/Sheridan Street and SR A1A/South Ocean Boulevard outside lane to close late July 2025 through December 2025

To ensure community and crew safety, the outside lane of eastbound SR 822/Sheridan Street and the outside lane of southbound SR A1A/South Ocean Boulevard between SR 822/Sheridan Street and New Mexico Street will be closed beginning at 8 p.m. Wednesday, July 23 through December 2025. This single lane closure is necessary to safely accommodate the work zone for drainage installation and roadway improvements.

Access to Hollywood North Beach Park will be maintained. Southbound SR A1A/South Ocean Boulevard from just north of SR 822/Sheridan Street to New Mexico Street will be reduced to one lane only. The bicycle lanes in this segment will be closed during this phase of construction. Signage will be in place to guide motorists and pedestrians.
