SR 710/BEELINE HIGHWAY LEFT TURN LANE TO EASTBOUND SR 708/BLEU HERON BOULEVARD TO CLOSE JUNE 9—AUG. 31

Beginning at 8 p.m. Monday, June 9, the southeast SR 710/Beeline Highway left-turn lane to eastbound SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard will be closed around the clock through approximately 6 p.m., Sunday, Aug. 31, for road construction and signalization activities.

- Motorists traveling southeast on SR 710/Beeline Highway to eastbound SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard will be detoured southeast on SR 710/Beeline Highway to north SR 809/Military Trail and east on SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard.
- Access for emergency and first responder vehicles will be maintained following the detour route. Signage will be posted along the detour route to assist motorists.
- Access to all businesses on SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard will remain open during this work.
