UNIVERSITY DRIVE IN CORAL SPRINGS MOBILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information on the mobility improvements along University Drive in the City of Coral Springs. The City of Coral Springs, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT design and construct the University Drive in Coral Springs Mobility Improvement Project through the City of Coral Springs Resolution No. 2016-036. The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward County and this project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access. The Broward MPO is a federally mandated agency that is responsible for making decisions on local transportation issues and deciding how to spend federal funds on transportation projects within Broward County. Construction Cost: \$13,650,945 Construction Start: January 2023 Estimated Completion: Spring 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening the roadway to accommodate one additional travel lane and bicycle lane
- Relocating the existing 6-foot sidewalk from NW 40th Street to SR 869/Sawgrass Expressway
- Relocating impacted drainage structures and regrading swales to ensure proper drainage flow
- Upgrading traffic and pedestrian signals at NW 40th Street and Westview Drive
- Installation of 77 light poles along the project corridor
- Milling and resurfacing within the project limits
- Upgrading curb ramps, signing, and pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures along University Drive from NW 40th Street to SR 869/Sawgrass Expressway, Wiles Road, and Westview Drive are permitted nightly, as needed, 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- NW 38th Drive will be closed during utility operations. Traffic will be detoured using SR 838/Sample Road, NW 85th Avenue, NW 38th Street, NW 84th Avenue, NW 40th Street, and University Drive
- NW 38th Street will be closed, as needed, for utility operations. Traffic will be detoured using Broken Woods Drive
- Motorist and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
