## Westbound Davie Boulevard Extension/Peters Road to close nightly starting Monday night, May 19

All lanes of westbound Davie Boulevard Extension/Peters Road will be fully closed to traffic nightly from 9:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m., Monday through Thursday, starting Monday, May 19 through Thursday, May 29. This closure is necessary to safely perform drainage installation in the median. Traffic will be detoured via northbound SR 7/US 441 and westbound SW 12<sup>th</sup> Street. Signage will be in place to guide motorists through the detour. Improvements as part of this project include: milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term infrastructure resilience; constructing raised medians from SW 46<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SR 7/US 441; installing drainage from SW 46<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SR 7/US 441 to enhance long-term infrastructure resilience; upgrading existing pedestrian signals at signalized intersections to improve push button accessibility; and upgrading curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to improve visibility and accessibility.
