

WESTBOUND LOXAHATCHEE ROAD WILL BE CLOSED AROUND THE CLOCK BEGINNING MONDAY, JUNE 9

Beginning Monday, June 9 westbound Loxahatchee Road between Parkside Drive and Nob Hill Road will be closed to traffic through early August 2025. The closure is necessary to safely perform roundabout construction operations at N University Drive and Parkside Drive.

- **Westbound traffic** will be detoured via southbound Parkside Drive, westbound Holmberg Road, northbound N University Drive, westbound Hillsboro Boulevard, and northbound Nob Hill Road.
- **Eastbound** traffic will be maintained via a traffic shift on Loxahatchee Road.

To ensure overall safety, FDOT urges motorists to use precaution as they traverse through the area. Pedestrian and cyclist access will also continue to be prohibited.



CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:


Roundabout construction will begin at **N University Drive** and will be carried out in **two phases**.

Phase 1:

A traffic shift will be implemented for eastbound Loxahatchee Road

- Closure of the northern portion west of Loxahatchee Road
- Closure of the southern portion east of N University Drive
- Westbound access from N University Drive will be restricted.

Advance notice will be provided prior to the start of Phase 2.
