
S.R. A1A/South Ocean Boulevard Drainage Improvements Project Full Closure to begin Tuesday, Jan. 20 at 11:59 p.m.

S.R. 822/Sheridan Street between S.R. A1A/South Ocean Drive and U.S. 1/Federal Highway will be closed to through traffic, around the clock, for 72 hours, beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. through Friday, Jan. 23, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. for roadway construction work. Eastbound and Westbound S.R. 822/Sheridan Street traffic will be detoured via U.S. 1/Federal Highway, Dania Beach Boulevard, S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard, and S.R. A1A/South Ocean Drive. Access will be maintained for local traffic, residents, businesses, and emergency services. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

Construction Cost: \$34.3 Million

Construction Start: July 2025

Estimated Completion: Summer 2028
