State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard and S.R. 862/I-595 from United States (U.S.) 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95

EASTBOUND S.R. 862/I-595 BETWEEN S.R. 84 & POND APPLE SLOUGH BRIDGE TO CLOSE OVERNIGHT OCT. 26

All lanes of eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 between S.R. 84 and Pond Apple Slough bridge will be closed to traffic from 10 p.m. until 4 a.m. on Sunday, Oct. 26 for overhead sign structure installation. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 10 p.m., reopening by 4 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via the S.R. 862/I-595 eastbound exit ramp (Exit 8 / 9A-B) to southbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7, eastbound S.R. 818/Griffin Road, and northbound S.R. 9/I-95 to access the S.R. 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp.

To ensure community and public safety, the following ramps will also be closed nightly:

- The eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 entrance ramp from northbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7
- The eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 entrance ramp from southbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7 and S.R. 91/Florida's Turnpike
- The eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 entrance ramp from S.R. 91/Florida's Turnpike and eastbound S.R. 84

The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area.
