The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information regarding the SR 842/Broward Boulevard Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation project in the City of Plantation.

Construction Cost: \$4.14 million Construction Start: January 2023 Estimated Completion: Fall 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the pavement throughout the project limits
- Reconstructing sidewalks, curb ramps, and upgrading detectable warning surfaces
- Upgrading traffic signalization
- Upgrading pedestrian signals with countdown timers and LED lighting at six intersections
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures are permitted daily from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Single lane closures are permitted nightly from 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, and 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., Friday and Saturday, for paving operations.
- Motorist and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
