## **PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS**

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway
- Modifying pavement markings along SR 5/US 1/Federal Highway to accommodate 4-foot bicycle lanes in each direction
- Extending the northbound left-turn lane on SR 5/US 1/ Federal Highway at NE 26th Street to increase vehicle storage capacity
- Upgrading existing signalization and lighting at various locations
- Upgrading signage, pavement markings, sidewalks, and curb ramps

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures along SR 5/US 1/Federal Highway are permitted Sunday through Thursday nights from 9:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- Motorist and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
