STATE ROAD 9/I-95 COPANS ROAD, INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information about interstate improvements at SR 9/I-95 at the Copans Road interchange in the City of Pompano Beach. Project improvements consist of constructing a dedicated merge lane for I-95 northbound traffic from Copans Road that is physically separated from the I-95 general purpose lanes. Improvements will also include constructing a parallel road for I-95 southbound traffic entering and exiting onto Copans Road.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Copans Road will be closed from 10 a.m. Tuesday, January 19, to 6 a.m. Wednesday, January 20, for striping, installation of temporary barrier wall, and I-95 northbound on-ramp from eastbound Copans Road traffic switch.

Detour Route:

- * Eastbound Copans Road traffic wishing to travel onto I-95 northbound should travel northbound on North Dixie Highway to Sample Road and then travel eastbound on Sample Road to the northbound on-ramp onto I-95
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp onto westbound Copans Road and the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Copans Road will be closed from 10 p.m. on Wednesday, January 20 to 6 a.m. Thursday, January 21, for striping, installation of temporary barrier wall, I-95 southbound off-ramp to westbound Copans Road traffic switch and the I-95 southbound on-ramp from eastbound Copans Road traffic switch.

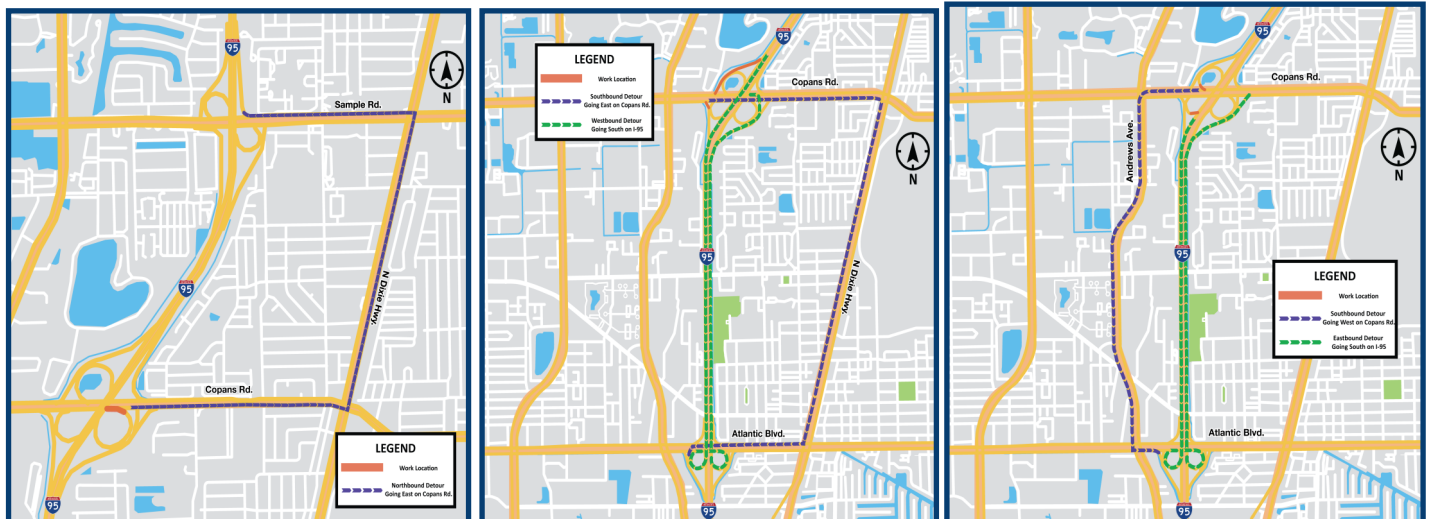
Detour Route:

- * I-95 southbound traffic wishing to exit onto westbound Copans Road should exit at West Atlantic Boulevard, travel east on West Atlantic Boulevard, enter the I-95 northbound ramp, travel north on I-95 and exit at westbound Copans Road.
- * Eastbound Copans Road traffic wishing to travel onto I-95 southbound should travel southbound on North Dixie Highway to West Atlantic Boulevard and then travel westbound on East Atlantic Boulevard to the I-95 southbound entrance ramp.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Copans Road and the I-95 southbound exit ramp onto eastbound Copans Road will be closed from 10 p.m. on Thursday, January 21 to 6 a.m. Friday, January 22, for striping, installation of temporary barrier wall, and traffic shifts for the I-95 southbound on-ramp from westbound Copans Road and the I-95 southbound off-ramp to eastbound Copans Road.

Detour Route:

- * Westbound Copans Road traffic wishing to enter I-95 southbound should travel southbound on North Andrews Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard, travel east on Atlantic Boulevard and merge onto the I-95 southbound entrance ramp.
- * I-95 southbound traffic wishing to exit onto eastbound Copans Road should exit onto eastbound West Atlantic Boulevard, merge onto the I-95 northbound entrance ramp, travel north on I-95 and exit at eastbound Copans Road
