The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four will host an in-person Construction Open House and Virtual Public Meeting regarding the mobility improvements along SW 184th Avenue and SR 858/Miramar Parkway in the City of Miramar. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

The City of Miramar, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the SR 858/Miramar Parkway Mobility Improvements Project through the City of Miramar Resolution 16-01. The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward County and this project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access. The Broward MPO is a federally-mandated agency responsible for setting policy on local transportation issues and deciding how to spend Federal and State funding on transportation projects in the Broward region. PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installing a paved 10-foot shared-use path along SW 184th
- Widening the roadway to accommodate a 7-foot bicycle lane along SR 858/Miramar Parkway
- Upgrading pedestrian signalization at the intersections of Miramar Parkway and SW 184th Avenue, SW 178th Avenue, and SW 172nd Avenue
- Milling, resurfacing, and replacing pavement markings at the intersections of SR 858/Miramar Parkway and SW 184th Avenue, and SW 178th Avenue
