The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the SR 7/US 441 Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project in the cities of North Lauderdale, Fort Lauderdale, and Tamarac.

Construction Cost: \$2 million Construction Start: March 2023 Estimated Completion: Fall 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing along the project limits
- Installing 5 light poles and upgrading existing lighting with LED fixtures
- Upgrading pedestrian signals at the following locations:
 - SR 7/US 441 and SR 870/Commercial Boulevard
 - SR 7/US 441 and Prospect Road
 - SR 7/US 441 and Bailey Road/NW 62nd Street
- Upgrading curb ramps, signing, and pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures will occur during non-peak hours from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Multi-lane closures may occur from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Business and residential access will be maintained at all times throughout construction.
