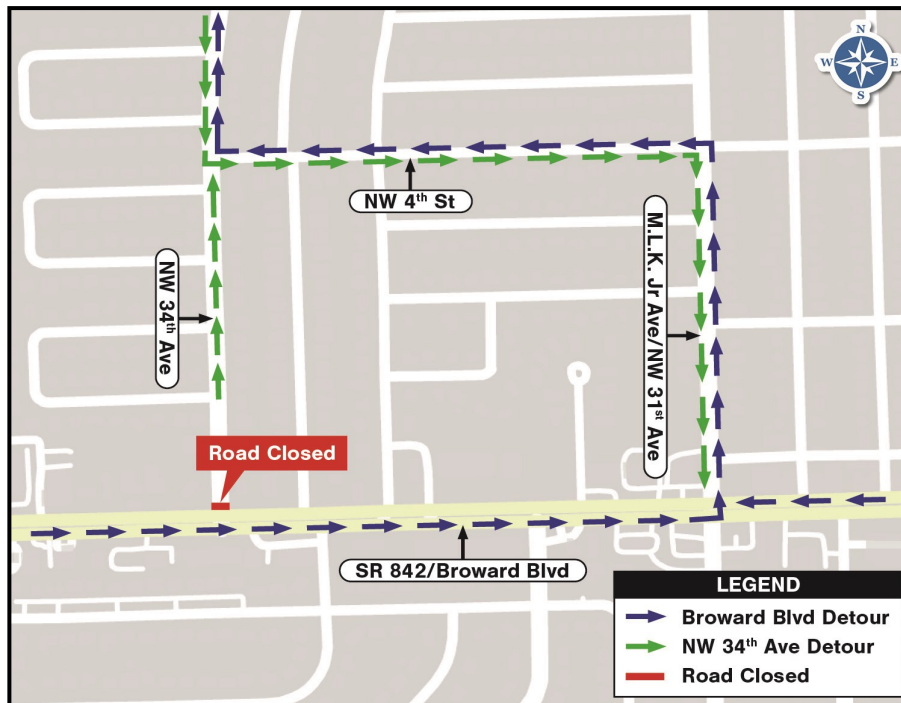

### NW 34TH AVENUE AT SR 842/BROWARD BOULEVARD TO CLOSE FROM 10 P.M., MARCH 15 TO 6 A.M., MARCH 18

NW 34th Avenue at SR 842/Broward Boulevard will be closed from 10 p.m., Friday, March 15, to 6 a.m., Monday, March 18, for crosswalk construction.

NW 34th Avenue traffic will be detoured via NW 4th Street, Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue/NW 31st Avenue, and SR 842/Broward Boulevard. SR 842/Broward Boulevard traffic will be detoured via Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue/NW 31st Avenue, NW 4th Street, and NW 34th Avenue. Posted signs will assist motorists.

SR 842/Broward Boulevard at NW 34th Avenue will have two lanes closed in either direction at any one time for crosswalk construction along SR 842/Broward Boulevard. Posted signs will assist motorists.



Construction Cost: \$7,262,972

Construction Start: July 2023

Estimated Completion: Fall 2024

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

This project improves all signalized intersections within the project limits by: installing 39 light poles and upgrading existing lighting with LED fixtures between SR 7/US 441 and W 27th Avenue, removing decorative paver crosswalks, extending median left turn lanes to increase vehicle capacity at various locations, milling and resurfacing the roadway, and upgrading signing and pavement markings.
