

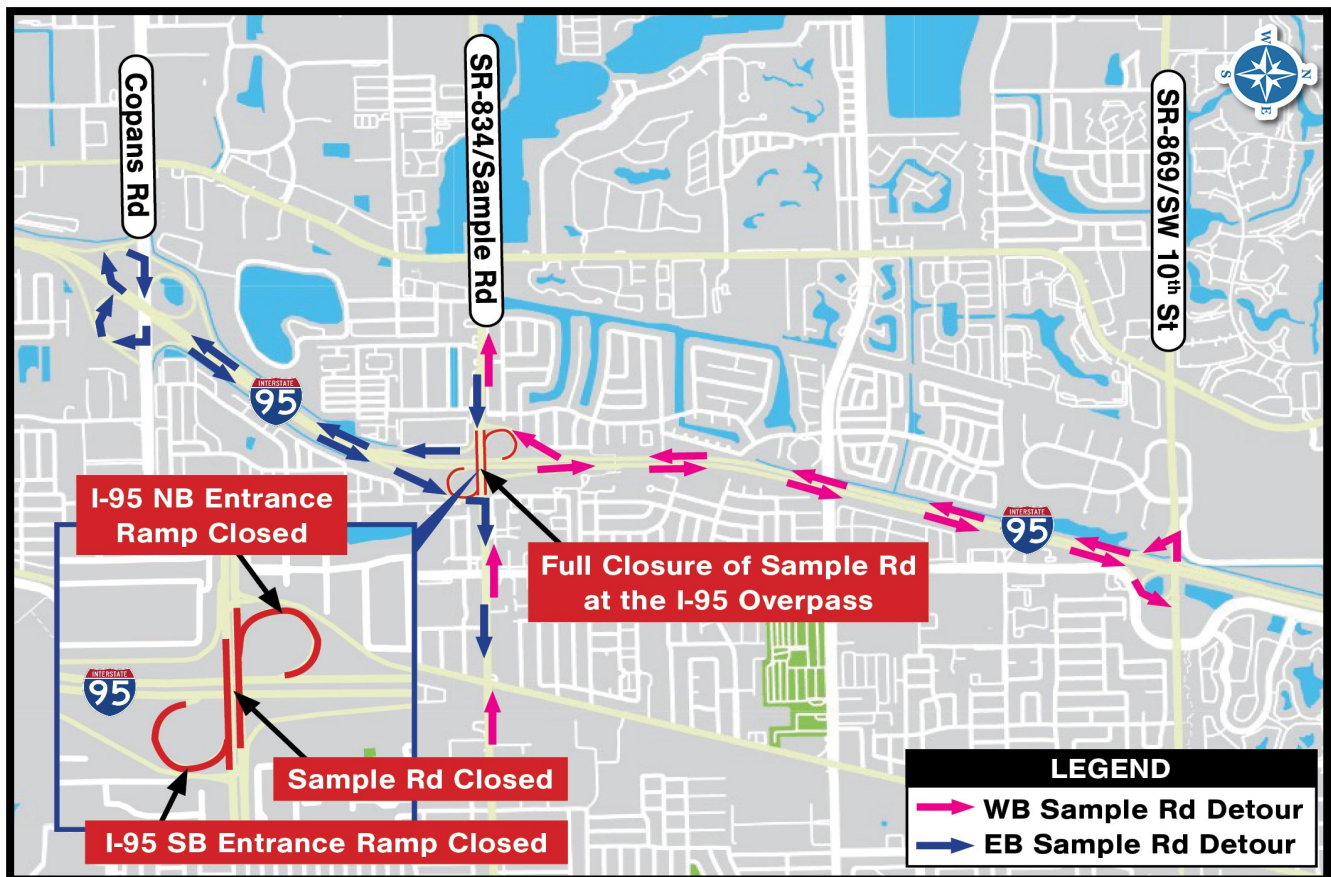

SR-834/SAMPLE ROAD AT I-95 TO CLOSE NIGHTLY MARCH 14—23

SR-834/Sample Road at SR-9/I-95, will be closed to traffic in each direction nightly, as needed, midnight until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Tuesday night, March 14 for bridge demolition operations. The first lane on will close at 10 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed at midnight, reopening by 5 a.m. In association with this operation, the SR-9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound SR-834/Sample Road and the SR-9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound SR-834/Sample Road will also be closed, midnight until 5 a.m. Westbound SR-834/Sample Road traffic will be detoured via northbound SR-9/I-95, SR-869/SW 10th Street, and SR-9/I-95 southbound. Eastbound SR-834/Sample Road traffic will be detoured via SR-9/I-95 southbound, Copans Road, and SR-9/I-95 northbound. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists. Sunday night, March 26 through Thursday night, March 31 will be used as contingency if needed.



Improvements as part of this project include constructing dedicated merge lanes for SR-9/I-95 northbound and southbound traffic from SR-834/Sample Road that are physically separated from the SR-9/I-95 general purpose lanes, constructing noise walls, installing signalization mast arms on SR-834/Sample Road at the SR-9/I-95 northbound and southbound off ramps and at the NE 3rd Avenue intersection, updating the lighting and the intelligent transportation systems (ITS) at the SR-9/I-95 and SR-834/Sample Road interchange, roadway and bridge widening, milling and resurfacing, signing and pavement markings, and widening and milling and resurfacing on NE 3rd Avenue from south of NE 35th Court to south of NE 38th Street.
